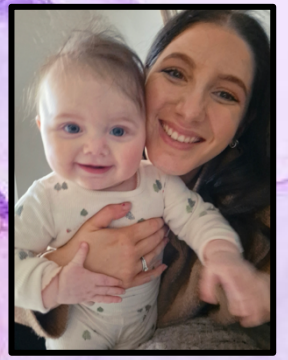


Mrs Moruzzi Year 3 Class

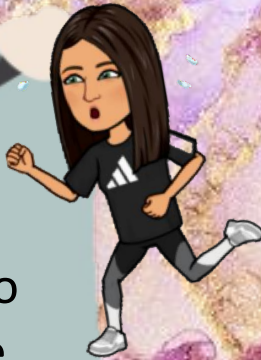


The reason I chose to be a primary teacher is because I love working with children and making learning fun and exciting for them!
