Forthcoming Year 5 & Year 6 Trips

Please find below details of two exciting trips planned for our Year 5 & 6 children. The Academy has subsidised these trips and is using our own transport where possible to keep the cost to parents to a minimum.

Trip 1

Event : World War II Experience

Place : The Brampton Museum

Dates : Tuesday 22nd October for **Mr Bond & Mrs Rosillo's class**

Wednesday 23rd October for **Mr Masterson's Class**

Cost : £2.61 (which includes entry to the museum) to be paid by 18th October

To further the children's knowledge and understanding of life during World War 2 at a local level, we will be visiting the Brampton Museum. Pupils will handle genuine artefacts from World War 2 and get to discover what life was like for the people of Staffordshire during the war.

The cost of this trip will be £2.61 (this has been subsidised by the Academy) and up to £3.00 may be brought in a named purse or wallet to spend in the gift shop. The trip will take place during normal school hours, we will travel to the venue in the school minibus and we would like the children to come to school **dressed in costume as war evacuees**.

The children will need to bring a packed lunch including a drink, all in a throw away container/bag (free school meal children will have a packed lunch provided).

Trip 2

Event : Into Film Festival – Johnny English Strikes Again (PG)

Place : Odeon Cinema

Date : Friday 8th November for the whole of Year 5 & 6

Cost : £3.00 (which includes travel, snacks and a drink) to be paid by 25th October

As part of the 'Into Film Festival' pupils in Year 5/6 will be visiting the Odeon Cinema in Crewe to watch Johnny English Strikes Again. This film will then form part of our English class/ letter writing skills.

Pupils will travel to the cinema via coach during the school day and a drink and snack is included in the cost and will be provided by the Academy.

We will return in time for lunch and children are required to wear full school uniform on the day.

You will be able to pay and give your consent for both of these trips on ParentPay unless your child is in receipt of the 'Pupil Premium' in which case they will receive a separate permission slip as the cost is met by the Academy.
